



How to get to the Upper Two Mile Trail (16)
 Go north out of Monticello on Highway 191. When you reach La Sal Junction turn east on Highway 46. Stay on Highway 46 through La Sal. Prior to coming to Old La Sal you will come to the junction of Highway 46 and County road 154 going northeasterly. Follow 154 for approximately 7 miles. You will be in an area known as Canopy Gap. You are now on trail 16, Upper Two Mile. This is a good area for staging. Refer to the map for trail details.

How to get to the Lower Two Mile Trail (17)
 Go north out of Monticello on Highway 191. At La Sal Junction, turn east on Highway 46. Drive through La Sal and Old La Sal on Highway 46. Approximately 2 miles past Old La Sal will be the junction between Highway 46 and County Road 125 going north. Take County Road 125 and follow it to Two Mile Creek. You are now on Trail 17, Lower Two Mile. This is the staging area. Refer to the map for trail details.

How to get to the Slaughter Flat Trail (18)
 Go north out of Monticello on Highway 191. At La Sal Junction, turn east on Highway 46. Go approximately 5 miles to the junction of Highway 46 and County Road 174. Go north on County Road 174 for approximately 4 miles. Just before 174 crosses under the power lines, notice a road (the trail) going to the north. You are now on trail 18, Slaughter Flat Trail. This spot is a good staging area. Refer to the map for trail details.

How to get to the La Sal Pass - Geyser Pass Trail (19)
 Go north out of Monticello on Highway 191. At La Sal Junction, turn east on Highway 46. Follow Highway 46 through La Sal. Before getting to Old La Sal you will encounter the junction of Highway 46 and County Road 154 going northeast. Turn onto 154 and almost immediately you will notice an area to your left that is well-suited for staging. You are at the beginning of trail 19, La Sal Pass/Geyser Pass Trail. The trail is about 80% on maintained County roads and for the most part is an easy ride. Refer to the map for trail details.
