

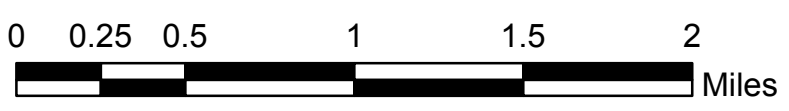


San Juan County Trail System

Hatch Point - Box Car Bridge Trail (36)

Take Highway 191 north out of Monticello. Near mile marker 86 you will see a sign for Needles Overlook and Anticline Overlook. Turn west on this paved road and go about 15 miles to the junction of the Needles Overlook and Anticline Overlook roads. Turn north on the Anticline road. In a very short distance you will see the trail sign for trail 36 to the east. This is the beginning of trail 36. The map shows trail details.

Trout Springs Trail (37)

To get to the Trout Springs trail follow the directions for the Box Car Bridge trail (36). Continue on the Anticline Overlook road past the trail number 36 sign for about 5 miles to a view area and a trail sign marking trail 37 to the east. This is the beginning point for trail 37, the Trout Springs trail. If you continue on the Anticline Overlook road for approximately 2 miles you will find signs indicating trail 37 crossing the Anticline Overlook road. Trail details are shown on the map.

Canyonlands Overlook Trail (38)

To get to trail 38 follow the directions for trail 37 then continue on the Anticline Overlook road for approximately 3 miles. Watch for trail signs indicating trail 38 crossing the Anticline Overlook road. You may ride trail 38 east or west of the Anticline road, preferably to the west. See the map for trail details. Have a great ride.

Behind the Rocks Trail (20, 21)

Go north out of Monticello on Highway 191 to mile marker 112. Just beyond this marker you will see a sign for Behind the Rocks. Turn to the west and you will be at the beginning of the Anticline road. Refer to the map for trail details.
