Hook and Ladder Trails

Go north out of Monticello on Highway 191. Just after passing mile marker 95 you will cross the Hatch Wash bridge. Just north of the bridge is the junction of Highway 191 with County road 114 (Steen Road). Turn right (east) on 114 and travel approximately 1 mile to a staging area sign. The staging area is on the left (north) side of County road 114. Refer to the map for trail details from the staging area.
